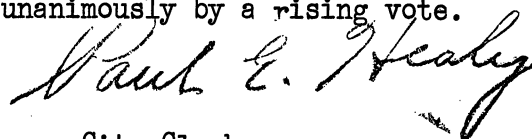
RESOLVED:-
