WHEREAS: This City Council has put in numerous orders relating to traffic and child safety in the area of schools and playgrounds; and

WHEREAS: Numerous responses have been received by the City Council from the Department of Traffic and Parking which indicated that all signage, etc. is appropriate for the areas; and

WHEREAS: In spite of this signage and present safety conditions children have still been injured in these areas; and

WHEREAS: An increase in the use of the playground areas is coming with the spring season; and

WHEREAS: This City Council has requested that a City Council hearing be set for the Director of Traffic and Parking to appear before the Council relating to these conditions; and

WHEREAS: The concerns expressed in previous Council Orders still prevail, particularly in the area of the Harrington School and Donnelly Field; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That Mayor and the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to schedule a public hearing on traffic safety in the areas of schools and playgrounds and invite through the City Manager, the Director of Traffic and Parking, the Police Commissioner and the School Department Personnel with notice to neighborhood groups and schools, as well as organized leagues which use these playgrounds.
