To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$13,766.00 into the general fund from the M.B.T.A. and the owner's 295 Harvard Street Trust to the Fire Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. These funds will be used for purchasing 59 new rubber nomex firecoats to replace the old coats which were contaminated with asbestos as a result of fires in M.B.T.A. trains as well as 10 firecoats which had to be replaced as a result of a cellar fire in an apartment building at 295 Harvard Street which involved a fire in an area where several bags of asbestos was stored.

The M.B.T.A. has agreed to reimburse the City for its share of the expenses which amounts to \$11,771.00 and 295 Harvard Street Trust is expected to reimburse their share of \$1995.00 to the City as mandated by the law.

Passage of this order is recommended.
