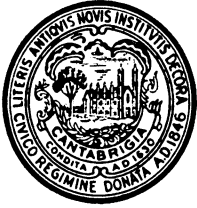

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the acceptance and appropriation of a grant for \$363,000.00 from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to the Community Development Extraordinary Expenditure account to provide funding for the Rental Rehabilitation Program. This program provides for the rehabilitation of substandard multi-family residential properties by funding low-interest loans up to \$5,000.00 per unit to qualified property owners. The project area includes six eligible Block Grant neighborhoods: Areas 1, 3, 4, 5, 7, and 11.
