In response to the above referenced Council Order, pertaining to the proposed renovation of the Haggerty School, please be advised that I have spoken with Mr. James Conry of the School Department regarding the matter, which will need to be placed in the City's five year Capital Improvement Program. Funding for such renovations may be hard to come by as there is a significant wait to obtain state funds through the School Building Assistance Bureau.

If City funds are to be used it will be necessary to review the Capital Plan to determine which project an entirely new City funded Haggerty School would replace and what the impact would be upon the tax levy.
