WHEREAS: The historic importance of the Central Square area of Cambridge was recently recognized by the Massachusetts Historical Commission, when, on January 29, 1991, the City was presented with a certificate designating Central Square as the Central Square Historic District; and

WHEREAS: Central Square continues to present issues of cleanliness, pedestrian congestion, and safety, as well as overall aesthetic issues; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council requests that the Community Development Department assemble a small study group to determine if existing efforts regarding improvements to Central Square are sufficient to begin realizing results by spring of this year - 1991 - or if a plan should be produced by the CDD regarding future improvements to Central Square; and be it further

RESOLVED: That in this process, the CDD consult with Cambridge activist Mr. Alan Zimlicki of Erie Street.
