To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 48, and after further review of the accident data at the intersection of Windsor & Harvard Streets, I am recommending an appropriation of \$50,000 from the parking fund for the installation of a pedestrian light.

I must advise the City Council that this will be the second appropriation from City funds for installations during FY91, the other being at Oxford and Forest Streets. In the past, all costs of Department of Public Works approved signals were paid by the Commonwealth. Due to the number of requests by the City Council for additional installations, I have been recommending one per year in the Capital Budget. Given the location of this intersection adjacent to a K through 3 school, I am prepared to recommend funding for a second signal in the FY91 Budget.

I must advise the City Council that any other requests for FY91, would only be possible if State funding were made available.
