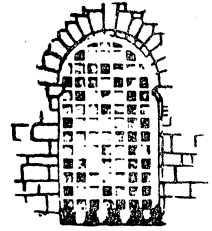

We thank you for receiving the president of

As per our conversation we wish to inform you
that our parish has scheduled its three-day Annual
Grecian Cultural Festival for Friday, Saturday and Sunday,
August 17, 18 and 19, 1984 on the church grounds at
14 Magazine Street, Cambridge, Mass. We request permission
to close Magazine Street between Franklin and Auburn Streets
on these dates from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.

On the last day of the Festival we will raffle
a car to benefit the Church Building Fund. This letter
is our request for your permission to allow us to display
the car in Central Square for the purpose of selling tickets.

For the purpose of advertising our Festival this

COUNCILLOR VELLUCCI

WHEREAS: This City Council is in receipt of a communication from Mrs. Pota Gianourakos, Church Secretary of the Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church, relative to its Three-Day Annual Grecian Cultural Festival to be held on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, August 17, 18 and 19, 1984 on the Church grounds at 14 Magazine Street, Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: In her communication Mrs. Gianourakos requests permission to display a car in Central Square during this time for the purpose of selling raffle tickets for the benefit of the Church Building Fund, and further requests permission to erect a sign on the lawn at City Hall for the purpose of announcing this year's Festival; said sign to be placed on the City Hall lawn about a month preceeding this event; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That this City Council go on record granting permission to Mrs. Pota Gianourakos, on behalf of the Saints Constantine and Helen Church, to display a car in an appropriate area as designated by the Commissioner of Public Works, at the intersection of Massachusetts Avenue and Prospect Street in Central Square during the time of this Festival; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to confer with the petitioner relative to the erection of a sign on the front lawn of City Hall.

IN CITY COUNCIL

February 27, 1984

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Mrs. Pota Gianourakos, Church Secretary, on behalf of the Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church, for the erection of a banner across Mass. Avenue in the Central Square area.

Provided that, before erecting the above named banner, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.) Dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner, and provided further that the petitioner obtain permission of the owners of the buildings to which said banner will be attached.

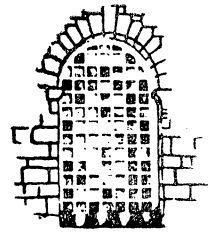
