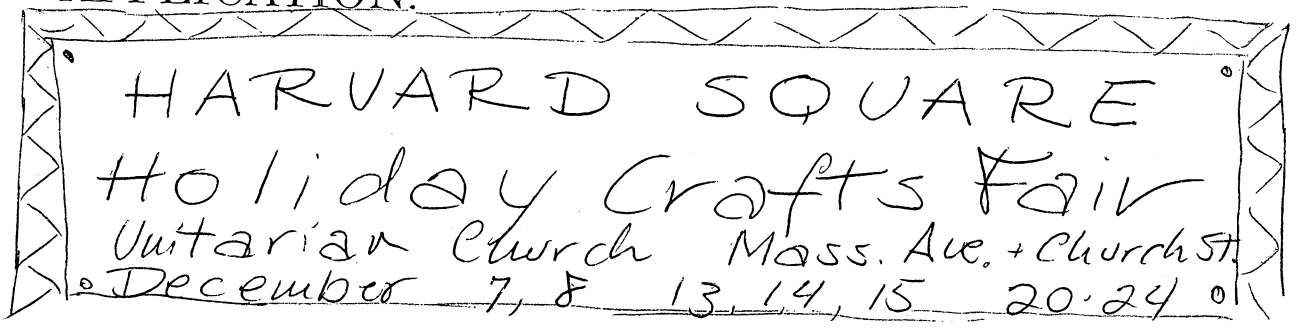

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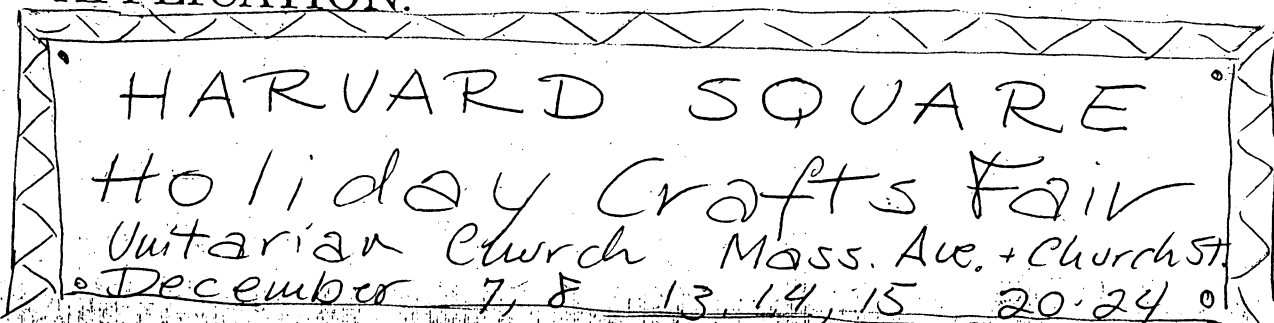

ORDERED: That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Unitarian Church, to hang a temporary banner across Massachusetts Avenue in front of City Hall, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Provided that, before erecting the above named banners the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the installation, maintenance and use of said banners.
