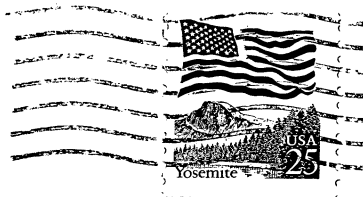

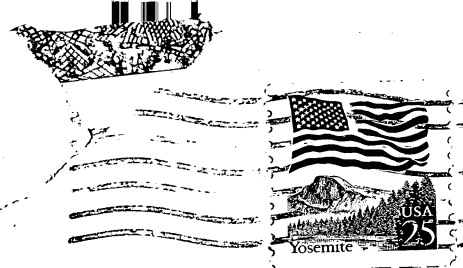
Dear Members of the Council:

We write to express our strong support of the Council's vote on May 8 to amend the city's rent control statutes. The proposal before the council--to decontrol three units in all owner-occupied buildings (of four to six units)--will make the city's regulation of the rental market far more equitable. The owners of such buildings have been left with the difficult task of maintaining affordable housing in Cambridge for over twenty years. They deserve credit and recognition for their vital contribution to the city's well-being. The proposal before you now will go a long way toward redressing an arbitrary and wholly unfortunate distortion of values that has led to the deterioration of the city's housing stock.

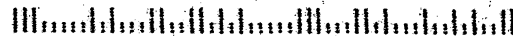

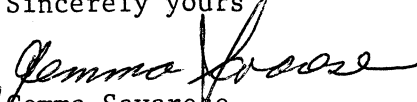

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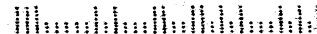
