 June 4, 1984

- WHEREAS: The Mayor of Ischia, Italy, the Honorable Enzo Mazzella and City Council has proposed a sister-cityship between the City of Cambridge and the City of Ischia, Italy; and
- WHEREAS: The Island of Ischia lies within the Bay of Naples, Italy, and is one of the most beautiful summer resorts in the South of Italy, near the Isle of Capri; and
- WHEREAS: The American sixth fleet is based in the Bay of Naples and thousands of American servicemen and women and American governmental personnel are living in the Naples area; and
- WHEREAS: Many of our American citizens do visit the Island of Ischia, from time to time because of its nearness to the City of Naples; and
- WHEREAS: The City government and the citizens of Ischia, Italy, are desirous of forming a sister-cityship between Ischia, Italy and Cambridge, Massachusetts, U.S.A.; and
- WHEREAS: Many of our first Cambridge Italian immigrants are from the Naples-Ischia region and settled mostly in the East Cambridge area where their descendents now reside; and
- WHEREAS: The City Government, the Chamber of Commerce, the Department of Education and various citizen groups welcome the opportunity to become associated with the City of Cambridge which possesses so much culture; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That this City Council go on record in favor of the creation of a sister cityship between Ischia, Italy and Cambridge, Massachusetts, U.S.A., and that copies of this resolution be sent to the Ischia Mayor and City Council.

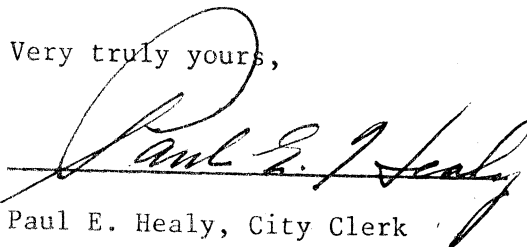
