COUNCILLOR SULLIVAN

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the City Solicitor to draft an amendment to the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge in Chapter 13, Article I entitled "Offenses Against Property" which will provide the following:

1. No political sign is to be placed on any property in the City of Cambridge except at the Headquarters of a political party, or in the case of a non-partisan election at the Main Headquarters of each particular candidate for office; and
2. A fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) shall be levied upon any person or persons guilty of violating this ordinance.
