WHEREAS: Blocked handicap access ramps, impedes safe transport for many who depend on the ramps; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and is hereby requested to insure that when the City conducts its snow-plowing, that the plowed snow does not block any handicap access ramps in the City.
