
COUNCILLOR WALTER SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: The citizens of Cambridge continue to request maximum police protection twenty-four hours a day throughout the entire City; and
- WHEREAS: The current number of sworn personnel of 265 patrol officers does not allow for the maximum police coverage of our citizens, both young and old; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Chief of Police in order to take the appropriate action to hire an additional twenty-five (25) patrol officers no later than June 15th, in order for those recruits to begin the Police Academy by July 1, 1984.
