To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$66,000.00 to the grant fund from the Massachusetts Committee on Criminal Justice to the Police Department Salary & Wages Account \$39,156.00 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$26,844.00 to provide additional funding that will allow the Police Department to expand the existing ongoing program in Area 4 as well as other designated areas concerning the containment of drug infiltration and other substance abuse in our Communities. The Cambridge Police Department is currently in the second phase of an Anti-Substance abuse grant awarded to the Middlesex County District Attorney's Office in collaboration with the Cambridge Housing Authority.

This Award is matched by \$66,000.00 that is already allocated in the FY91 Police budget.
