Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that Chester Street, from North Avenue to the Souwillee line, should be laid out as a public way:-

Therefore Ordered, That said street, between the points above mentioned, be laid out as a public street, or way, by forty feet in width, according to a Plan of the same, drawn by J. G. Chase, City Engineer, dated Nov. 30, 1870, and now before this Board.

Ordered, That no damages be awarded to the persons over whose land said Chester Street is laid out as aforesaid.
