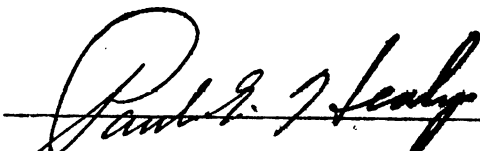
COUNCILLOR DAVID SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: Lola, as an employee in the Admission's Office of Harvard University, recognized the need for a support group at the University for university students, faculty, and staff who had life-threatening diseases, founded Liferaft in 1982 and the sessions of this group were well attended and found to be helpful and insightful; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to James Minifie and to the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
