The recent murder of Professor Mary Jo Frug near our School has caused a great deal of fear and anxiety for our staff, parents and neighbors. Shortly after April 4th, David O'Connor, the parent of one of our 3rd Grade students, began working with me to arrange a meeting of the BB&N community and our neighbors with the Cambridge Police to discuss our fears.

Together with Police Chief Henry Breen, Mr. O'Connor was able to organize a meeting on April 25th with Lieutenant Harold Murphy, Inspector James Dwyer, and Officer Jeanne Murrell at our Middle School campus on Sparks Street. Over 100 parents, staff, and neighbors were able to be present to discuss their concerns with safety and protection as we all work to understand this terrible tragedy in our community.

We are fortunate in Cambridge to have such a responsive, professional police force and emergency management department. Please extend my personal thanks, and those of our staff at BB&N to Chief Breen and Mr. O'Connor for their help and cooperation.
