In Board of Aldermen Nov 22^d 1871

Whereas: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that a certain Street between Milk Street in Cambridge and Elm Street in Somerville heretofore called "Cottage Street" should be laid out as a public Street, Ordered, That a strip of land extending from said Milk Street to said Elm Street, being so much of the land included between the red lines shown on a Plan drawn by J. G. Chase City Engineer dated November 15th 1871 and now before this Board, as lies within the limits of the City of Cambridge, said strip being thirty three feet in width from Milk Street to the westerly line of "Cottage Court" so called and thence about twenty seven and one half feet in width, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street, by the name of White Street.

Ordered, That damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, as follows.
