Walter J. Kelliher, 84

Was eight-term mayor of Malden

A funeral Mass will be said today for Walter J. Kelliher, a former mayor of Malden, who died Monday in this daughter's home in Methuen. He was 84.

Mr. Kelliher was the mayor of Malden from 1958 to 1959 and 1960 to 1975. During his eight terms in office he oversaw an urban-renewal program that revitalized the city.

He was also chairman of the board of directors of the Massachusetts Housing Finance Agency from 1979 to 1982, and was a former president of the Massachusetts Mayors Association, the Massachusetts League of Cities and Towns and the state chapter of the Society for Public Administration.

Mr. Kelliher was born in Malden, attended the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and graduated from Northeastern Law School.

A World War II Navy veteran, he practiced law for many years as a member of the firm of Kelliher & Callaghan.

He was a member of the Kiwanis Club and the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

He leaves a daughter, Nancy K. Gladstone of Methuen; a sister, Margaret Donahue of Melrose; and two grandchildren.

The funeral Mass will be said at 11 a.m. in Immaculate Conception Church in Malden. Burial will be in Forestdale Cemetery in Malden.
