- WHEREAS: The Matignon High School boys varsity ice hockey team ended its 1983 - 1984 regular season by recapturing the Catholic Conference Championship; and
- WHEREAS: This year's team, guided by head coach Marty Pierce and assistant coaches Joseph McCabe and William Walsh, had a record in conference games of thirteen wins, one loss and two ties, and an overall season record of sixteen wins, two losses and two ties; and
- WHEREAS: Matignon has won twenty-three consecutive Eastern Massachusetts Schoolboy Tournament games, has made eight straight appearances in the EMass final, and has captured the overall state championship title the last three years it was presented; and
- WHEREAS: Matignon's season record was twenty-one wins, two losses and two ties, clutching their fifth straight Eastern Massachusetts championship with a 4-3 victory over Saint Peter Marian; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating Coach Marty Pierce and the Matignon High School boys hockey team as this year's Catholic Conference Champions, and extend its best wishes to the team for continued success in future seasons; and be it further

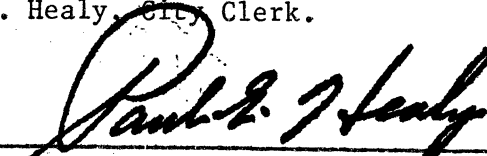
