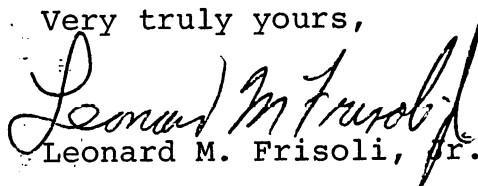
Gentlemen:

Please be advised that this office represents Anna Iantosca, of 571 Cambridge Street, Cambridge, Massachusetts, as a result of personal injuries sustained after stepping on debris, to wit: rocks and pebbles, on Sciarappa Street, East Cambridge, Massachusetts on November 9, 1977, at approximately 4:15 in the afternoon.

The approximate cause of the accident was an accumulation of stones in the area where my client was walking along Cambridge Street in a westerly direction on the side of Cambridge Street where the entrance to St. Francis' Church exists. My client then proceeded to cross Sciarappa Street to pick up the sidewalk on the other side and was approximately ten feet from the curbing when she stepped on some stones and pebbles which had been allowed to accumulate there as a result of construction work being done on Cambridge Street. As a result of stepping on said stones, she lost her balance and fell, injuring herself, and causing severe injury to her shoulder.
