ORDERED:

That the deed and sale of real estate by the City of Cambridge to Edward B. Morgan and Charles A. Slager, dated June 1, 1891 and recorded in Middlesex South District Deeds Book 2050, page 251 of lot No. 60 on a plan of building lots belonging to the City of Cambridge, dated April 10, 1884 and recorded in Middlesex South District Deeds Book of Plans 42, plate 19, be ratified and confirmed as the act and deed of the City of Cambridge.

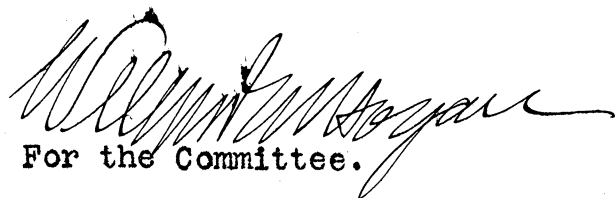
