An Ordinance

in relation to the construction and
repairs of Reservoirs and Hydrants.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows:-

Sec. 1. The Ordinance in relation to the
duties of the Engineers of the Third Department,
passed March 9th 1864 is amended by striking
out the words "as well as the Engines and
other Fire Apparatus" and adding the
words "but it shall be the duty of the Super-
intendent of Streets and Drains to have
charge of their construction, [and see that
they are kept in proper repair.]"

In Common Council May 2, 1864

Amended by striking out all after the word construction
in the first section, and inserting in place thereof
the words "And make such repairs as may require the
breaking up of Streets or Sidewalks", and as amended
