VICE MAYOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: The uses placed on industrially zoned land in the City are changing dramatically, making existing zoning obsolete; and
- WHEREAS: In many cases, industrially zoned land abuts or is surrounded by residential areas, making the developments clash head on with the requirements for safety and quiet desirable in residential areas; and
- WHEREAS: The City Council affirmed these concerns in November, 1986 by passing an order requesting the Community Development Department to make recommendations concerning areas where industrially zoned land is surrounded by residential areas and the Department has embarked on a study of such areas; and
- WHEREAS: Now in the Kendall Square area, differences have come to a head in the proposal to build a 1500 car garage; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the Community Development Department embark on a study of the Industrial B zoned land abutting Kendall Square.
