To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$102,660.00 into the Grant fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$84,850.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$17,310.00) and the Travel and Training Account (\$500.00) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Drug Elimination grant funds have been awarded to the Boston Financial Group, Walden Square Apartment Limited Partnership in partnership with the Department of Human Services Programs and the Federal Management Inc., which manages the Fresh Pond Apartments. The purpose of the award is to provide a positive alternative to substance abuse for young people living in housing developments in North Cambridge. DHSP will coordinate and support programming for per-teen and teen housing residents by hiring a Youth Services Coordinator and two Assistant Coordinators. A Peer leadership program will also be initiated by DHSP.
