In Board of Aldermen, Sept. 8, 1868

The Committee on Roads and Bridges to which were referred the Petitions of Sumner Allen and others for the widening of Essex Street between Austin and Main Streets, has considered the same and would recommend that said Street be widened upon the North westerly side, by taking ten feet in width from the estates of Robert Surpless, Edward Wyck, and Wm. J. Clearwin and by rounding the corner of Hossea Spencer's land at the corner of Essex and Austin Streets, all as shown on a Plan by J. G. Chase, City Engineer, dated Aug. 17, 1868, and now before this Board.

The adoption of the Order herewith submitted is accordingly recommended.
