I petition for permission to sell on the streets near Central, Porter and Inman Squares, between the hours of 10 A.M. and 6 P.M. I agree to obey all traffic and other municipal ordinances, and to avoid areas where my presence might annoy or compete with other stationary merchants. If the council wishes to establish particular areas where I may or may not sell, I will be happy to abide by those restrictions.

Because my primary obligation is to my family, selling my jewelry will not be a constant or even regular occupation. However, on the occasions that I do wish to sell my work, I wish to be legal, and of course to pay the appropriate taxes.

For these reasons I respectfully petition the Honorable City Council of Cambridge for a permit to sell my jewelry on public property in the City of Cambridge.
