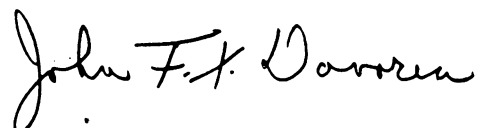

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows: Purposes for which the corporation is formed are to promote, foster, and assist in the elimination of sub-standard housing, the reclamation restoration and rehabilitation of blighted areas and the construction of new housing in cooperation with local, state and federal agencies.

This corporation will be operated exclusively for the purposes herein set forth and not for pecuniary profits. No part of its profits, if any, will inure to the benefit of any private member or individual or part used or appropriated for other than such purposes. The corporation is irrevocably dedicated to and operated exclusively for non-profit purposes.

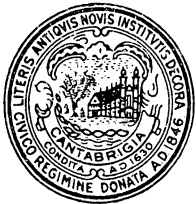
And in furtherance of such purposes, this corporation may acquire, hold, manage, invest, reinvest and dispose of property, whether real or personal, and wherever situated and whether received by gift, bequest, devise or in any other manner and carry on any activity in connection with the purposes permitted in Chapter 180 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

This corporation shall not apply for an exemption from taxation at the local level and in the event of dissolution the net assets of the

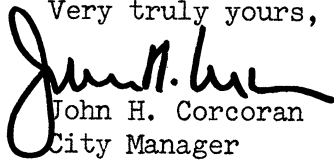
