- WHEREAS: Cosmo maintained a private practice in Cambridge for forty-two years and was active in several organizations, including the Massachusetts and Middlesex Bar Association, the Justinian Law Society, the Massachusetts Trial Lawyers Association and he was a past President of the Warren Pals Club in East Cambridge and
- WHEREAS: Even after Cosmo "officially" retired in 1980, he just could not remain away from the judicial system, so he served as a Public Defender with the Middlesex Bar Association; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Eleanor (Tammaro) Borgioli and to the entire Borgioli family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
