- WHEREAS:** Ms. Haley first began her long 43 year career as a teacher at the former Kelley Elementary School and later became a teacher at the Harrington School in 1965; and
- WHEREAS:** Ms. Haley transferred to Cambridge High and Latin School in 1974 as a Guidance Counselor, the position from which she will retire; and
- WHEREAS:** Through her many skills and talent, she was able to provide expert assistance to thousands of students at the school who sought her out for advice and friendship; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation to Ms. Dorothy Haley on the occasion of her retirement and to further extend to her every good wish for continued good health and happiness in the years ahead; and be it further
