That the sum of ~~four~~ ^{Three} hundred dollars be placed at the disposal of the Commissioners appointed by Sec 6, Chap 302, of the Acts of the Legislature of 1870, for the purpose of enabling said Commissioners to pay the necessary expenses of printing, advertising, making plans and specifications &c, of the proposed new draws in West Boston Bridge; and the Mayor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant upon the City Treasurer for the payment to said Commissioners of the sum above mentioned, the same to be charged to the Appropriation for Care and Repairs of Bridges.
