ALL LICENSED BICYCLE DEALERS - SECOND HAND DEALERS - IN CAMBRIDGE, MUST SUBMIT TO THE CAMBRIDGE POLICE DEPARTMENT A LIST OF THE SERIAL NUMBERS, MAKE AND MODEL OF ANY BICYCLE SOLD OR BOUGHT. ALSO THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF PERSON SOLD TO OR BOUGHT FROM, AND SALE PRICE OR AMOUNT PAID. THIS LIST MUST BE SUBMITTED ON A WEEKLY BASIS. FORMS WILL BE SUPPLIED TO ALL DEALERS BY THE CAMBRIDGE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Director of the Rent Control Board to prepare a report for this City Council which would include the cities across the country which currently have or have had some form of rent control, whether or not it be a rent control board, a rent regulation board or a rent control administrator; and be it further

RESOLVED: That said report include the criteria used to determine exactly how it is that only low-income persons were in fact residing in rent controlled units.
