- WHEREAS: The Central Square Association has initiated a privately funded study of rubbish and litter collection in Central Square, and
- WHEREAS: The Commissioner of Public Works has met with representatives of the Central Square Association and agreed to implement a coordinated rubbish collection system including night time collections, additional sweepers, enclosed litter baskets, and new mechanical equipment, and
- WHEREAS: The Central Square Association has assumed responsibility for properly notifying all residents, business operators and property owners in the Central Square business area concerning collection schedules and responsibilities for proper bundling of rubbish and disposal of litter, and
- WHEREAS: The Chief of Police has agreed to implement a Code Enforcement Citation Process with performance goals given legal assistance to develop and print such citation books, now be it therefore
- RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby applauds and supports efforts by the Central Square Association, the D.P.W., and the C.P.D. and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and is hereby requested to provide adequate legal and printers assistance necessary to prepare a Code Enforcement Citation Book that includes but is not limited to;
1. Vandalism, Destruction of Property and other Related Offenses (Ord. No. 853, Sept. 29, 1975)
 2. Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages on Certain Public Places (Ord. No. 825, Dec. 17, 1973)
