AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an Ordinance entitled: "The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge".

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

SECTION 1: The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge are hereby amended by inserting, after Section 2-30, of Chapter 2, Article IV, entitled Administration, Departments, new Sections 2-31 through 2-35, inclusive, as follows:

Sec. 2-31. Assistant City Manager for Economic Development and Manpower Affairs serves as Administrator of Economic Development and Manpower Affairs.

The Assistant City Manager for Economic Development shall serve as the Administrator of Economic Development and Manpower Affairs, and shall have responsibility for the proper functioning and general effectiveness, as well as the general supervision and control, of Department of Economic and Industrial Development and Manpower Affairs which may be created by ordinance or otherwise, at some future time, and of those other local departments, divisions,

boards, agencies, commissions, and officers, such as the Office of Economic Development, Office of Manpower Affairs, and the Industrial Development Financing Agency, in which the City Manager's office has a direct interest or responsibility, and for the maintenance of effective working relationships with those organizations of a local, regional, State, or Federal nature, or organizational subdivision thereof, such as the Cambridge Housing Authority, the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority, the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA), the Massachusetts Department of Community Affairs (DCA), the Massachusetts Department of Transportation and Construction (DTC), the Massachusetts Department of Commerce and Development (DCD), or the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), the Department of Transportation (DOT), and the Department of Commerce (DOC), and the Department of Labor (DOL), in which the City Manager's office has an indirect interest or for which it has a related responsibility, and whose functions in all instances relate to overall economic and industrial development and manpower programs intended --through the design and implementation of new programs, project, activities, systems, procedures, and funding arrangements, or through the modification of existing ones-- to improve economic conditions, facilities and services, to strengthen economic and industrial

development resources, and to meet current and future economic and industrial development requirements, as well as those pertaining, in a similar manner, to organization for economic and industrial development and manpower work, to the development of basic data and information systems, to economic and industrial development services, and manpower affairs.

Section. 2-32. Appointment and term of Assistant City Manager for Economic Development and Manpower Affairs.

The Assistant City Manager for Economic Development and Manpower Affairs shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the City Manager. It is the intention of this provision to fix all responsibility and invest all authority for the appointment and removal of the Assistant City Manager for Economic Development and Manpower Affairs in the City Manager.

Section 2-33. No Civil Service or tenure rights.

The Assistant City Manager for Economic Development and Manpower Affairs shall have no rights under Civil Service, nor acquire any rights of tenure in any manner.

Section 2-34. Powers and duties of Assistant City Manager for Economic Development and Manpower Affairs.

The powers and duties of the Assistant City Manager for

Economic Development and Manpower Affairs shall be such as are designated and assigned from time to time to the Assistant City Manager for Economic Development and Manpower Affairs by the City Manager. The Assistant City Manager for Economic Development and Manpower Affairs shall have all the powers, rights, and duties that the City Manager shall determine as are necessary for the proper functioning and general effectiveness, as well as for the general supervision and control, of the departments, divisions, boards, agencies, commissions, and officers, consistent with the powers and duties assigned to him by the City Manager.

Section 2-35. Compensation for Assistant City Manager for Economic Development and Manpower Affairs.

The Assistant City Manager for Economic Development and Manpower Affairs shall receive as annual compensation the same amount set forth in Section 2-191 of this Chapter, for Assistant City Manager.

SECTION 2: The Assistant City Manager for Economic Development and Manpower Affairs shall receive dollars annually.

SECTION 3: Existing Sections 2-31 through 2-227, inclusive, in their present order, shall be re-numbered as Sections 2-36 through 2-232, inclusive.
