To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$364,375 in the Grant Fund from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services to the Human Services Department Salary & Wages Account (\$184,939), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$170,296) and Travel & Training Account (\$9,140). The funds are received from the Center of Substance Abuse Prevention and are awarded directly to Human Services as the lead agency of the Substance Abuse Task Force. The grant focuses on alcohol, tobacco and other drug abuse prevention on a community wide basis, involving all constituencies. Specific project activities include: training parents, clergy and other "gatekeepers" in prevention strategies; involving youth as leaders in their community; building community networks; collaboration with the Police Department; and general community education.
