This letter is a request for permission to close Amherst Street from Massachusetts Avenue to Danforth Street on Sunday June 14, 1981 for the purpose of holding a bicycle fair. This is the third year the Bicycle Coalition will be holding its Bike Fair in Cambridge. Bike Fair '79 and '80 were held on Memorial Drive and Flagg Street.

This year the fair is planned to be held on M.I.T.'s Briggs Field behind Kreskie Auditorium. The fair will include displays on bicycle safety, cycle touring, commuting by bicycle as well as refreshments from a number of Cambridge restaurants. There will also be a limited amount of selling of low cost bicycle safety related equipment on Amherst Street.

In conjunction with the fair there will be a 50 kilometer bicycle race on Memorial Drive sponsored by Yoplait Yogurt. All planning for these events is being coordinated with M.I.T. and the M.D.C. We would be pleased to work with the Cambridge Traffic and Parking Department also.
