It has been noted that city employees transport containers of trash to the sidewalk for the residents of 115 Brattle Street at no extra charge; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager confer with the Commissioner of Public Works and assure that, if this is an ongoing and continuous practice regarding the residence cited, the same service should be provided under the same terms and conditions for all elderly, handicapped and sickly people throughout the city. Equality is indivisible. Some are not more equal than others; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to this Council by May 14, 1990 with a determination on this matter.
