Dear Mr. Scali:

As you may recall, on December 12, 1994, the City of Cambridge granted our petition for a jitney license to operate a sight seeing tour under the provisions of Chapter 159A of the Massachusetts General Laws over the following public ways: Longfellow Bridge to Main Street to Broadway to the Mid Block Connector to Main Street to the Longfellow Bridge. At this time we are petitioning the City of Cambridge to stop on Main Street as we head back out towards the Longfellow Bridge. We feel that this stop is important for Cambridge as well as all of the merchants in the Kendall Square area. We only intend to make five to six stops, a day, in Cambridge, once every hour and a half. It is our understanding that a Trolley already has a stop in place and we would simply like the license to stop in this same location.

Enclosed is a copy of our business certificate as well as the petition granting our trolley the license to travel into Cambridge.

This is to advise you that the License Commission voted 2-0 on March 30, 1995, to recommend to the City Manager approval of the application of Gideon Oknin d/b/a Discover Boston on the Freedom Trail to amend his jitney license.

The License Commission heard this application on March 28, 1995.

The new route, as recommended by the License Commission, would be as follows (amendment is underlined):

Crossing over the Longfellow Bridge, into Cambridge, around the Marriott Hotel and Kendall Square and allowing a stop on Main Street as the trolley heads backs towards the Longfellow Bridge. This new stop would be determined by the Department of Traffic and Parking.

I enclose the letter of application to amend their license which must now be presented to the City Council for final approval. The original conditions of their Jitney License would remain in effect:

1. That the seating capacity of the trolley be limited to thirty-four passengers.
2. That no stops are requested by the petitioners and if additional stops are required in Cambridge that the request be made a separate request by the petitioner to the City.

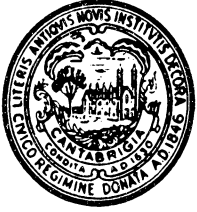
