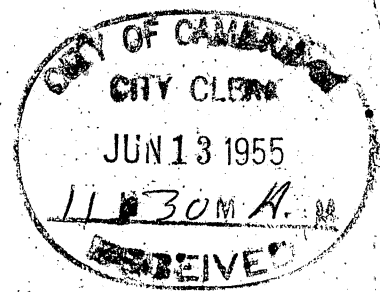

Petition of Cambridge Electric Light Company for determination by the Department of Public Utilities that the present situation of land located at #21 Healey Street in the City of Cambridge and the substation to be erected thereon, are reasonably necessary for the convenience and welfare of the public and that said land and the building and substation to be erected thereon be exempted from the Zoning Bylaws of the City of Cambridge.

Upon the foregoing petition the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, on Wednesday the 29th day of June, 1955 at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon.

And the petitioner is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least 14 days prior to said date in the Cambridge Chronicle and Boston Herald and to serve a copy hereof by registered mail at least 14 days prior to said date on the Mayor and City Clerk of Cambridge, Chairman of the Planning Board and all persons owning or having an interest in any abutting property, and to make return of service and publication at the time of hearing.

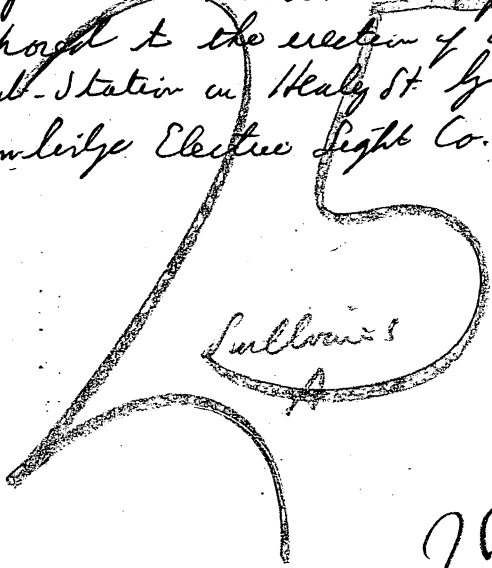
