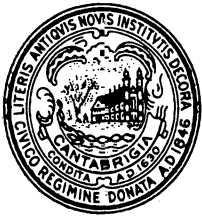

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows: Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Int. Rev. Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Revenue Law). No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Further, to encourage, foster, initiate and promote a non-partisan interest in and study of the business and fiscal activities of all federal, state, county, and municipal government agencies, in their relation to the people of the City of Cambridge, and to assist such governing bodies in maintaining as efficient and
