SECTION 5. Section 127E of said chapter 111, as most recently amended by section 5 of chapter 104 of the acts of 1978, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "cities of Boston and Worcester" and inserting in place thereof the following words: cities of Boston, Worcester and Cambridge.

SECTION 6. The third sentence of section 127H of said chapter 111, as most recently amended by section 6 of chapter 104 of the acts of 1978, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "cities of Boston and Worcester" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- cities of Boston, Worcester and Cambridge.

SECTION 7. The first sentence of the first paragraph of section 127L of said chapter 111, as most recently amended by section 7 of chapter 104 of the acts of 1978, is hereby amended by striking out the words "cities of Boston and Worcester" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- cities of Boston, Worcester and Cambridge.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

The City of Cambridge, by vote of the City Council of said city, hereby petitions the General Court to enact the following legislation:- "AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE STATE SANITARY CODE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF HOUSING INSPECTION IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE"; and further requests the legislative delegation from said city to file said legislation in the General Court.

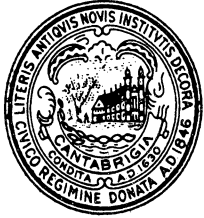
