- WHEREAS: The City Manager and Chief of Police informed the City Council at a recent hearing that requirements for police recruits have become more stringent, increasing the time it has taken to get 29 new recruits into training; and
- WHEREAS: There has been considerable concern on the part of the City Council and the community that there is too little police presence on Cambridge streets; and
- WHEREAS: There is continuing attrition in the ranks of the police department that can be predicted and which plans can be made; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is requested to work with the Chief of Police to begin the recruitment of a new class of police officers as soon as possible, planning for those positions which will be vacated and synchronizing with the police examinations; and further be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the City Council on the steps taken.
