That the Committee on Roads and Bridges be authorized to incur an expense not exceeding the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, (\$2000) towards the building of a sea-wall for the river wharf on the City property north of the River Street Bridge. The work upon said sea-wall to be in accordance with plans drawn by the City Engineer, and to be done either by contract, or by the day under the direction of the City Engineer, at the option of said Committee.

The expense so incurred to be charged to the appropriation for Incidental expenses.
