In Board of Aldermen, Nov 11 1868

The Committee on Ordinances, who were instructed by a joint Order of 21 Oct last, "to examine and report whether some change ought not to be made in the Ordinance establishing a schedule of Water Rates, in order to insure a more equitable rate of charges for the use of the Water, and to guard against the liability of waste" beg leave to report, that in pursuance of their duty they have conferred with a Committee of the Water Board and ascertained the views of that Board in regard to the inequalities in the Rates as now established, and report herewith an Ordinance, which if adopted, will, in their judgment, remedy all difficulties.

The Committee <sup>having</sup> compared the Water Rates of Boston, Charlestown, Hartford and Philadelphia with our own, feel very confident, that, if the Ordinance now reported, be adopted, the Rates of Cambridge will be more equitable and just than those of either of the cities named.
