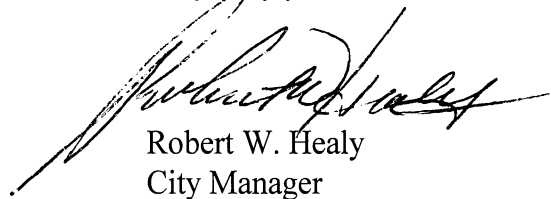

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$14,000.00 to the Inspectional Services Travel & Training (Judgement & Damages) Account \$5,000 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$9,000. The funds will support additional costs related to providing transcription services for the Board of Zoning Appeals. The increase is the result of a 35% increase in case hearings and hearings running longer than in the past.

The funds in the damages account are needed to cover the expenses of arbitration in a compensation case involving an Inspectional Services employee at the Industrial Accident Board. The funds for this appropriation will come from additional revenue.
