To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$60,000 from Free Cash to the Finance (Personnel) Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to provide funds for services related to the City's labor and discipline cases. The funds will be used specifically to cover expenses for legal counsel, arbitrator fees, American Arbitration Association filing fees, and transcript preparation fees. Costs in this area have grown significantly as the City continues to litigate an increasing number of Police Department (approximately 77% of the total expenses) and Fire Department (15.3%) cases.
