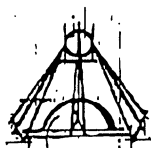
It is important to note that through the work of the Vice-Mayor's office as well as the efforts of Sue Walsh at the Office of Workforce Development, this job fair is only advertised in Cambridge, thus, allowing Cambridge residents the first opportunity to access these jobs.

Jobs will be given to persons not residing in Cambridge only when the search process in Cambridge has been exhausted. This same process was utilized and supported by Forest City Development in recent job fairs conducted by Star Market and CompUSA. These job fairs were very successful and resulted in over 300 Cambridge residents being hired by Star and approximately 50 Cambridge residents were hired by CompUSA. 100% of the employees hired by Star are Cambridge residents and approximately 50% of CompUSA's are Cambridge residents.
