This complaint was reviewed by the Department and more particularly by Mr. Robert Keating, Highway Foreman, who answered Mr. Anderson on May 10, 1983. Specifically: Oxford Street was posted with temporary "No Parking" signs to allow for sweeping on the Friday in question; it could not be swept on the regularly scheduled day due to heavy rain. The judgement was made to do this rather than wait another three weeks because of the condition of the street.

Because of problems involved in the use of temporary signs, there will be no further attempt to "reschedule" work days without full assurance, if possible, that work will be completed without misunderstandings. Prior notice will be given to your office, Police and Traffic Departments in the event of citizen calls.

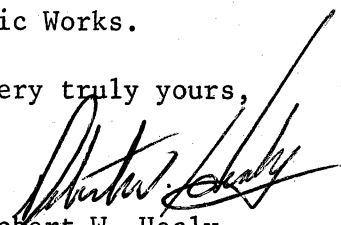
