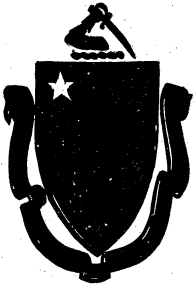
Enclosed please find a resolution regarding the trackless trolley service on the North Cambridge line from Alewife to Harvard Square.
